### TO BE (active verb tense) + PAST PARTICIPLE (of the main verb)

#### PRESENT SIMPLE (am/is/are +PP)

- -People speak English in Australia.
- \*English is spoken in Australia.

### PRESENT CONTINUOUS (am being/is being/are being +PP)

- -They are building a garage.
- \*A garage is being built.

#### PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE (have been/has been +PP)

- -Mary has just bought a ticket.
- \*A ticket has just been bought by Mary.

### PAST SIMPLE (was/were +PP)

- -Shakespeare wrote *Hamlet*.
- \*Hamlet was written by Shakespeare.

## PAST CONTINUOUS (was being/were being +PP)

- -The police were watching the house.
- \*The house was being watched by the police.

## PAST PERFECT SIMPLE (had been+ PP)

- -He had read the book.
- \*The book had been read.

## MODALS/ GOING TO/ USED TO +BE+PAST PARTICIPLE

- -He has to do it. \* It has to be done.
- -We used to eat a lot of sweets. \* A lot of sweets used to be eaten.
- -Peter will certainly see that film. \* That film will certainly be seen by Peter.
- -Students should not wear uniforms. \*Uniforms should not be worn by students.
- -Are you going to sell the house? \* Is the house going to be sold?
