- Compare with other sources



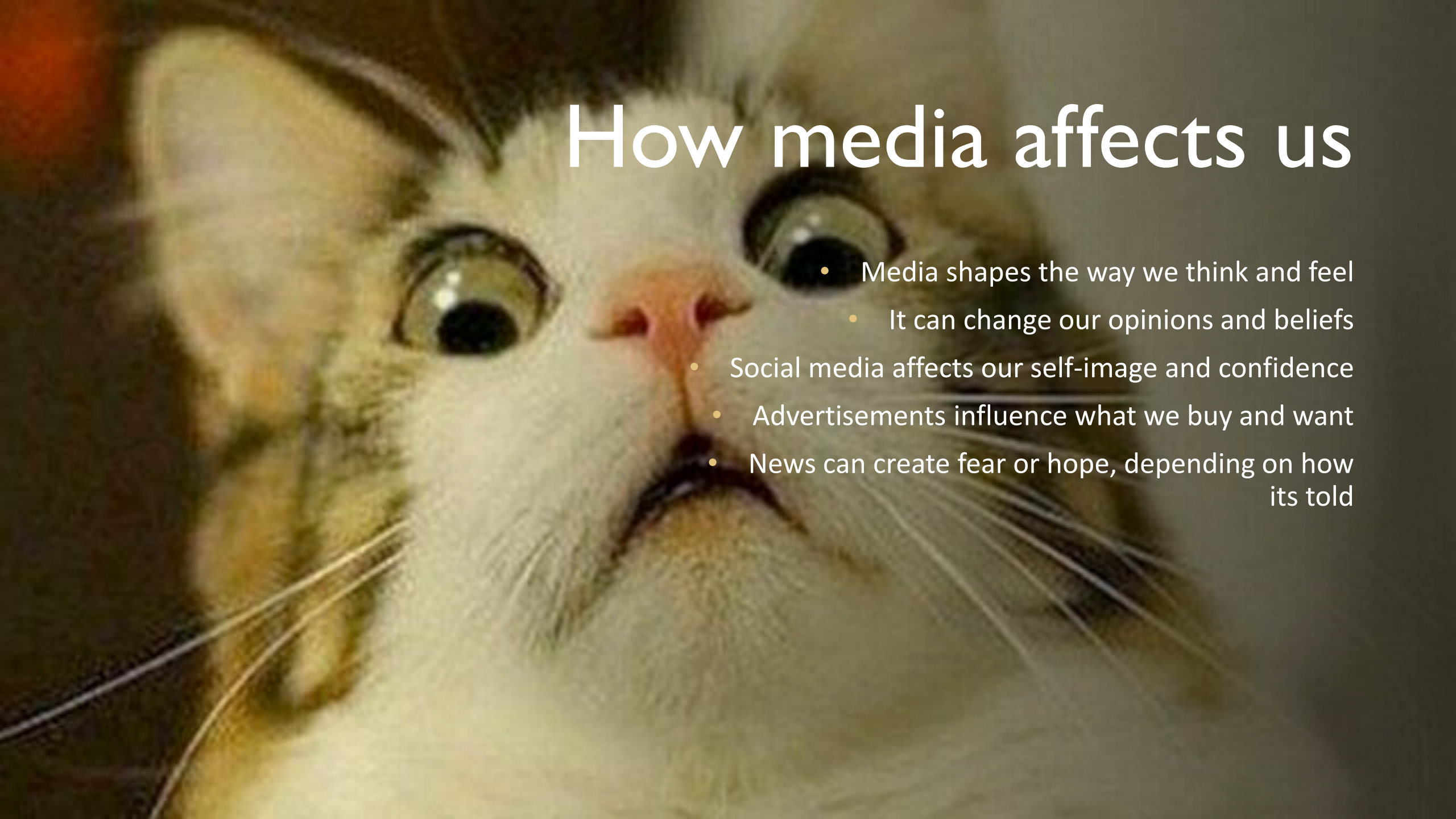
Digital literacy

- News can create fear or hope, depending on how its told

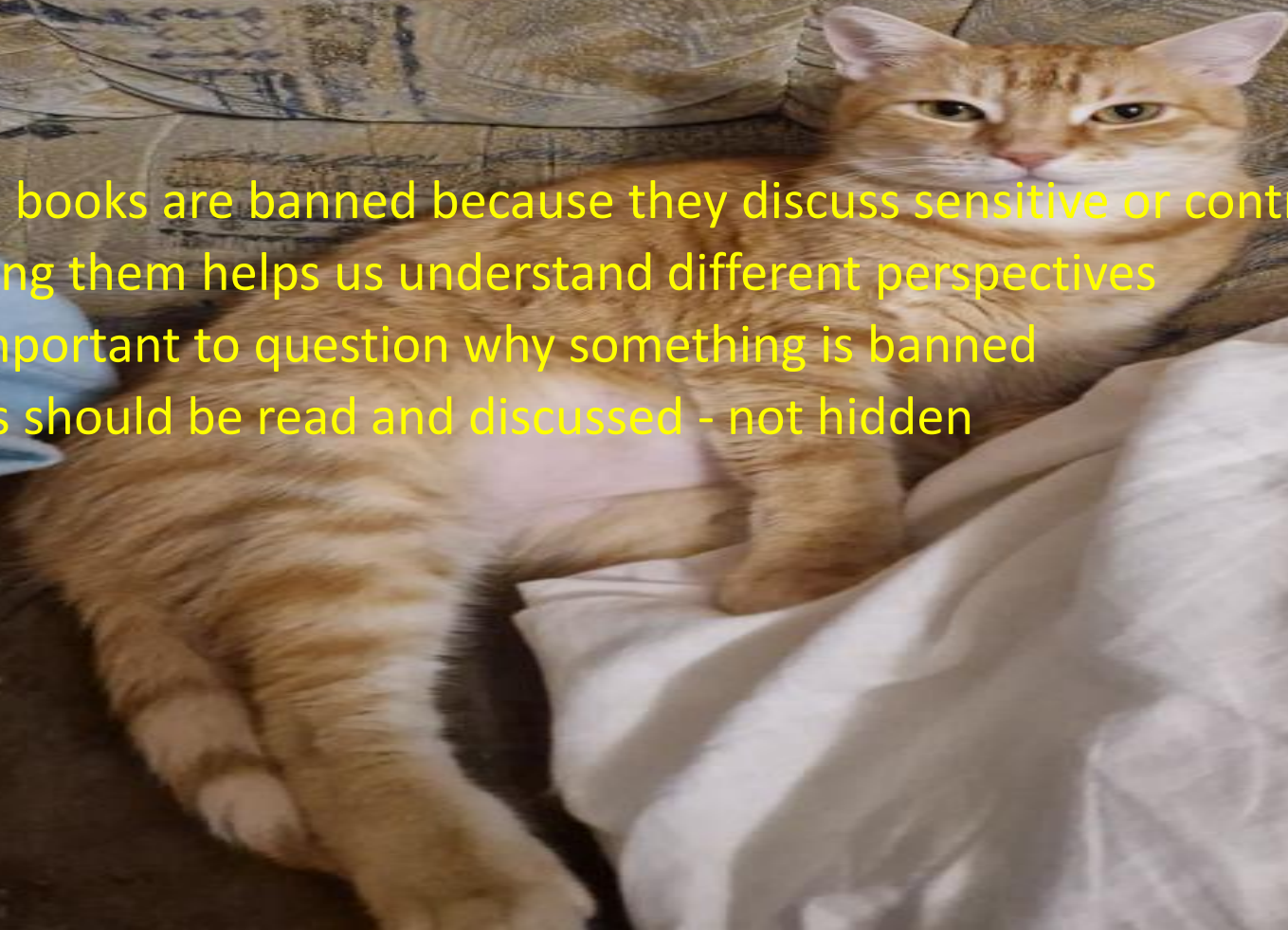
Why it matters

- Using media in a way that makes us smarter, not easier to influence



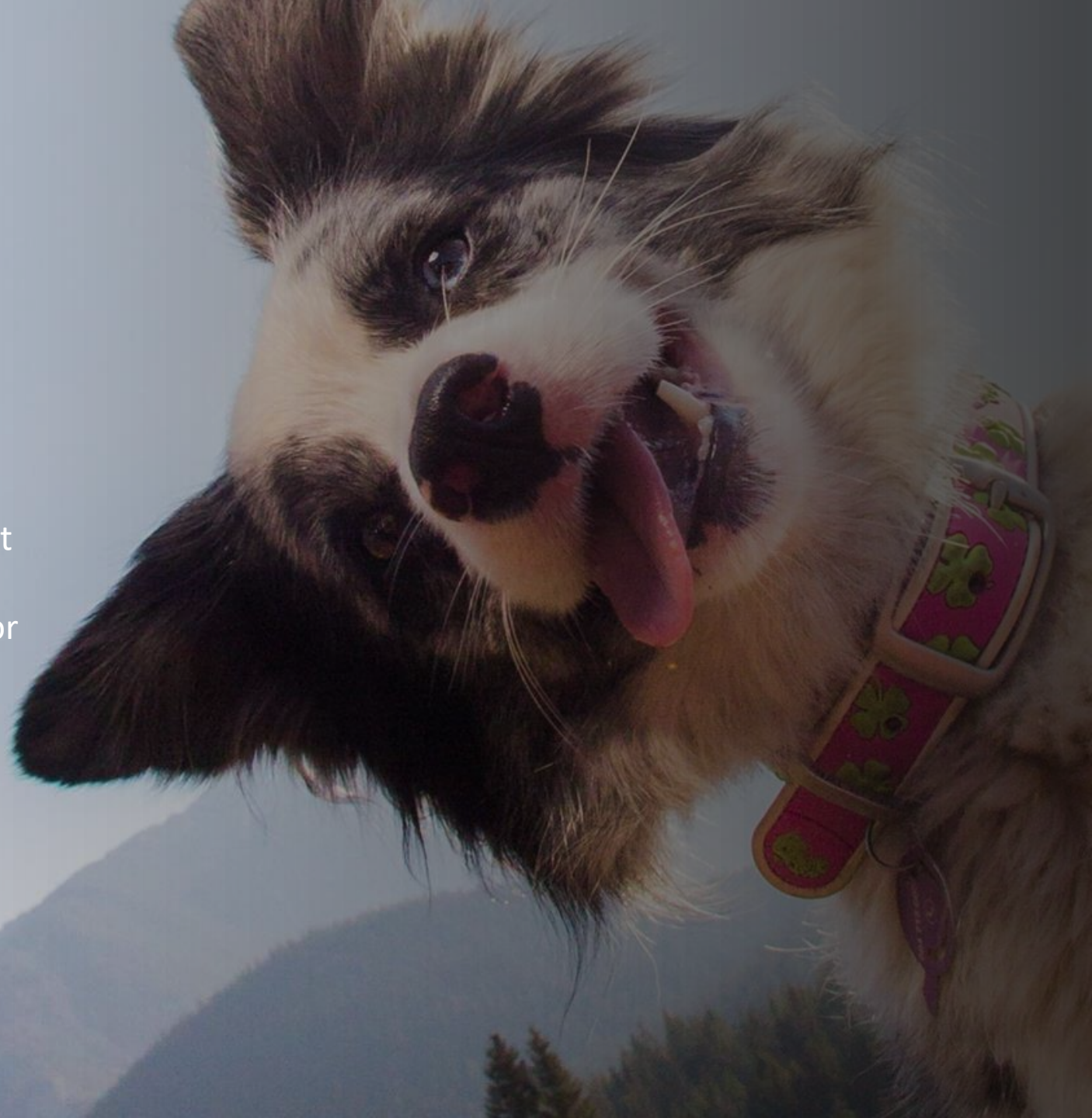
Banned books
